Return Changes for Students in Year 3 - Year 12

Dear PCS Families,

I trust this letter finds you well. I would like to advise that there have been some changes to the return to school plan that was emailed to you on 23rd April. We are looking to fast track the return of students where we can and as such have decided to bring students in Years 3-10 back for additional days from next week. We have also decided to bring students in Year 11 and 12 back on a full time basis from next Monday 11th May.

From Week 3, students in Years 3 - 10 will attend school for two days. This is an increase from the one day that was previously published. Please see the updated table below and specific dates for each year group. Year 11 and 12 will attend school full time from Week 3.

Year 3 and 4 will attend school on Wednesday and Thursday of Week 3 (13th and 14th May) and Wednesday and Thursday of Week 4 (20th and 21st of May).

Year 5 and 6 will attend school on Monday and Tuesday of Week 3 (11th and 12th May) and Monday and Tuesday of Week 4 (18th and 19th May).

Year 7 and 8 will attend school on Monday and Tuesday of Week 3 (11th and 12th May) and Monday and Tuesday of Week 4, 5, 6 (18th, 19th, 25th, 26th May and 1st and 2nd of June).


Year 9 and 10 will attend school on Thursday and Friday of Week 3 (14th and 15th May) and Thursday and Friday of Week 4, 5, 6 (21st, 22nd, 28th, 29th May and 4th and 5th of June).

Year 11 and 12 will attend school full time from Monday 11th May.

Please note that it is compulsory for your children to attend school on the set face-to-face days published above. At-Home work will not be set for students on those particular days. Most importantly, if you are not comfortable sending your child to school on the days indicated within this plan, I would invite you to give me a call or email so that we can work on a solution that suits school and home. This would certainly be applicable to vulnerable students with specific health conditions.

I am confident that the increase in face-face-days falls within the limited guidelines provided by the NSW Government, and is consistent with our desire to keep our students, staff and families safe as we move back to full time face-to-face teaching.
